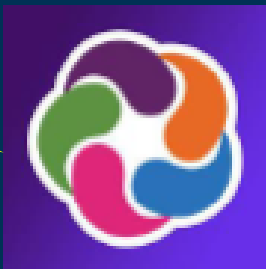

The Synergy Parent Vue app provides access to information about your student's attendance, grades, class assignments, and more. Synergy Parent Vue is also used for high school registration course request approval, online registration, and selected fee payments.

**Log in to your Synergy Parent Vue account and pay the following fees with a credit card online (OLR must be completed and approved first):**

Athletic-Activity/Spectator Pass*	\$40
Athletic-Activity Participation Fee	\$25
Cooperative Loss (Technology Insurance)	\$20
Senior Transcript Fee (Seniors only)	\$5
Parking Permit	\$40
Yearbook (optional)	\$70

\*If you do not pay for an activity spectator pass at orientation and choose to participate at a later date, there will be a \$5.00 fee to cover the cost of making a new ID.

# SPORTS & ACTIVITIES PARTICIPATION

Students participating in sports must:

## #1

### **Complete OLR**

Must say YES to sports participation and include insurance information



## #2

### **Turn in their physical form**

Sports physicals are required for Student Athletes who will be Freshmen in the 2020-2021 school year or did not submit a physical in the 2019-2020 school year.

New physicals must be dated after May 1, 2020.



## #3

### **Pay the \$65 athletic participation fee**

Fee will be listed as \$40 Activity Fee and \$25 Sports Fee, must pay both



Fall practices start August 10th

Student-Athletes must complete steps 1-3 before they may start to practice.

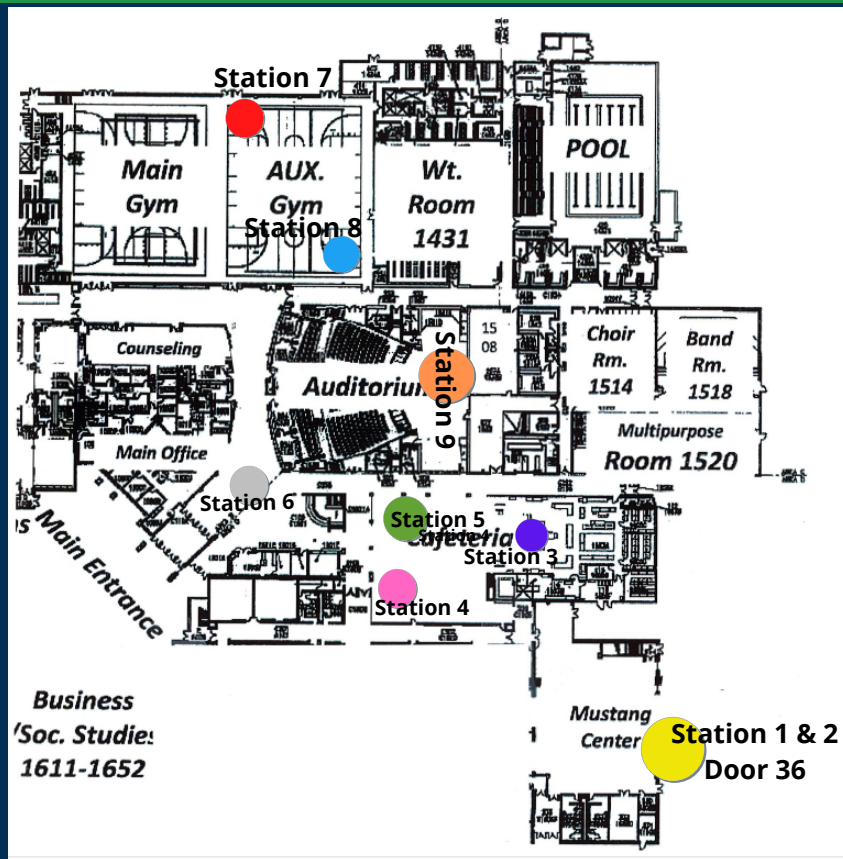
