Set up your Synergy Parent Vue



The Synergy Parent Vue app provides access to information about your student's attendance, grades, class assignments, and more. Synergy Parent Vue is also used for high school registration course request approval, online registration, and selected fee payments.

Log in to your Synergy Parent Vue account and pay the following fees with a credit card online (OLR must be completed and approved first):

Athletic-Activity/Spectator Pass*	\$40
Athletic-Activity Participation Fee	\$25
Cooperative Loss (Technology Insurance)	\$20
Senior Transcript Fee (Seniors only)	\$5
Parking Permit	\$40
Yearbook (optional)	\$70

*If you do not pay for an activity spectator pass at orientation and choose to participate at a later date, there will be a \$5.00 fee to cover the cost of making a new ID.
